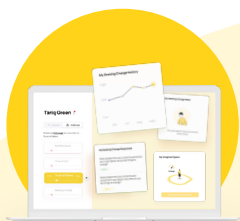

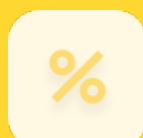

How to build your STEER Leadership Team

We know that effective implementation is all about making sure you have the right people, in the right role, with the right level of training and support. We also know that relationships are important. That is why each STEER school is given their own STEER Consultant who will work closely with your STEER Leadership Team. They train, resource and equip your team to securely implement every aspect of STEER Tracking.



We Provide:



A STEER Consultant

I am an experienced school leader, who used STEER in my own school before joining STEER as a consultant.

My role is to train, resource, and equip your team to implement STEER in your school. I guide your team from Launch to Accreditation, building the knowledge, skills and process to integrate STEER within your pastoral care systems.



STEER Technical Support

Our role is to work closely with your Data Manager to guide data import and answer any data security questions. Our school support desk will resolve your technical issues, and is available to all of your colleagues.

Your school will appoint



Strategic Senior Practitioner

I am on the SLT, and will probably hold one of these roles: Deputy Head Pastoral, DSL, Head of Wellbeing.

My role is to oversee the strategic implementation of STEER, such as introducing STEER to parents, and reporting STEER impact to the governing body. I attend all virtual meetings with our STEER Consultant.



Operational Senior Practitioner

I am likely to be a Head of Year or Head of House who is aspiring to Senior Pastoral Leadership.

My role is to oversee the operational implementation of STEER, such as scheduling online training and planning student assessment dates. I also attend all virtual meetings with our STEER Consultant.



STEER IT Lead

I am likely to be the Data Manager of your school.

My role is to oversee the technical implementation of STEER, such as completing the Wonde API process to import MIS data to the STEER platform. I work closely with the STEER Tech Support Team, but don't attend meetings with our STEER Consultant.



Senior Pastoral Leaders

We are Heads of Year or House, SEND Coordinators, Designated Safeguarding Leads.

In Year 1 we are trained by our STEER Consultant to prioritise our vulnerable students, write actions plans and review their impact, working closely with a lead tutor. In Year 2 we train all our tutors to take responsibility for their own data. In Year 3 we integrate STEER data with other school metrics.

How STEER supports your journey from launch to accreditation

Schools are busy places...

That's why we've developed a 3 year process that is paced, incremental, sustainable and achievable. Because we believe your most valuable resource is your staff, our implementation process upskills colleagues through a cascade training model. By Year 3, all colleagues will be responsible for prioritising, acting on, and reviewing their own students' STEER data.



In Year 1

In year 1, our focus is on **training** your STEER Leadership Team to confidently introduce and securely launch STEER.



In Year 2

In year 2, our focus is on **scaffolding** your STEER Leadership Team to cascade knowledge and skills, and processes across the school.



In Year 3

In year 3, our focus is on **guiding** your STEER Leadership Team as they integrate STEER data within your wider pastoral processes and other student data metrics.

Year One



First, you'll meet your STEER Consultant, who will walk you through your STEER Platform, and help you organise your online training.



Then, your STEER Consultant will help you import your data, explain how to introduce STEER to your school, and plan your STEER assessments.



All students from ages 8 -18 complete the STEER assessment!



After the tutorial, each Senior Pastoral Leader selects a lead tutor or colleague from their team who they train as a Lead Tutor. The Lead Tutor will prioritise vulnerable students from their tutor group and write a small number of student action plans.



After each assessment round, Senior Practitioners and Senior Pastoral Leaders attend a virtual Post Assessment Tutorial. Your STEER Consultant models how to prioritise and support vulnerable students from a selected tutor group within a selected year group or house.



Mid-year, your STEER Consultant reviews implementation with Senior Practitioners; measuring impact and building success!



At the End of Year Review, your STEER Consultant and Senior Practitioners meet to measure STEER impact, review progress towards STEER accreditation, plan how to cascade training across the whole school, and use Assessment 3 data for transition.

Year Two



In Year 2, your STEER Consultant will guide your STEER Leadership in how to cascade training across the school.



All tutors and new staff complete online training, scaffolded by your STEER Leadership Team.



All colleagues take responsibility for prioritising and supporting their vulnerable students and measuring the impact of student action plans.

Year Three



Now your focus is on integrating STEER data with other school data such as academic, safeguarding, attendance, and SEND data.



You might want to integrate additional STEER modules: Safeguarding, School Impact or PSHE



At the End of Year Review, your STEER Consultant will evaluate whether you have met the **STEER Accreditation** standards!
